

## Top 10 Mistakes At Child Changeover

- 1. Fighting, arguing and being abusive at changeover
- 2. As long as it is safe, avoid use of police stations for changeover.
- 3. Not providing relevant information about the children eg. Medication and dosages required
- 4. Being late for changeover
- 5. Failing to welcome or say goodbye to the children.
- 6. Not returning items that belong at other parents house
- 7. Using the children as messengers. There are lots of options for communication that don't require you to involve your children as messengers.
- 8. Being overly emotional at changeover: Crying and telling the children how much you will miss them is not appropriate for handover and may end upsetting the children and causing them worry. Put on a happy face, wish your children a good time with the other parent and say your goodbyes.
- 9. Failing to encourage the children to say hello and goodbye to the other parent or to even go with the other parent.
- 10. Consider who you bring with you to changeover, will this cause distress or anger in the other party or children.
